In the near future, assessments and awards of certain benefits, including DLA and Carers Allowance, will become the responsibility of the devolved Scottish Government.

The consultation which accompanies this process has the aim of creating a more humane award system.

The focus groups give participants a voice and a chance to shape the future of the social security system in Scotland.

What? Why? Children in Hospital are a Scottish charity who produce videos explaining various hospital tests and investigations performed on children and give helpful suggestions on how to prepare children for them.

They are about to begin filming their current project in Glasgow this month.

We are delighted to say that the Scottish Association for Children with Heart Disorders have funded the video and that some of our members will feature in it!

The film is being made in collaboration with the cardiology, psychology, and play specialist teams at Glasgow and will address the issues faced by our teenagers and young people.
